

Section A Scope *

Purpose

The purpose of Safety & Environmental Management Manual (SEMM) is to instruct the fleet and shore-base staff on policies and procedures in compliance to the International Management Code for the Safety Operations of Ships and Pollution Prevention, commonly known as the ISM Code and ISO 14001 Environmental Management System Requirements.

The safety and environmental management system shall cover all offshore supply tugs and Accommodation Barges operated and managed by the company.

Applications

Due to the unique and different nature of non-propelled Accommodation Barge operations, a separate manual called “Barge Instruction Manual (BIM)” is applicable especially for Accommodation Barge only.

SEMM is applicable to all self-propelled vessels operated under the Company Document of Compliance, but the following Sections only (marked with an * in the Section headings and sub Sections) are also applicable to on non-propelled Accommodation Barge:-

Sections A, B, C, 1, 2, 3.0 to 3.1, 4, 6, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13.

It is acknowledged that Ratings may not be proficient in reading the SEMM in the English language. The contents are therefore to be briefed verbally to them by the Master or persons delegated by the Master.

In the Applicable sections for the Accommodation Barge, where this manual refers to Master and Chief Officer, it applies to Barge Master, and where it refers to Chief Engineer and Second Engineer it applies to Barge Engineer.
